

Over 40 recommendations including ...



- Forge an overarching strategy for housing and care for older people, with the needs of those with living with dementia, including from BAME and LGBT communities
- Strengthen the DHSC's Care and Support Specialised Housing Fund Prospectus to take on board recommendations of this report
- Support increased provision of Extra Care Housing/ Assisted Living accommodation and retirement housing that is dementia-ready, with Homes England and the GLA Affordable Homes Programmes
- Promote more widespread adoption of Dementia Dwelling Grants via DFGs

But this is also about us:

- People should consider potential future loneliness and how we can maintain our family connections and wider social networks in the communities we live in before or after a diagnosis of dementia.
