### Innovations in dementia



- Make available funding for innovation to mainstream dementia ready design and technology e.g. for retailers and manufacturers
- Incorporate design and technology features set out in the new dementia-ready HAPPI design principles
- Recognise the interdependency between housing, social care and the NHS in supporting people with dementia and correspondingly rethink funding to prevent the need for higher-cost services.
- Ensure that those providing care and support for people living with dementia sign up to be dementia 'friends' and have appropriate training and supervision



### What next?




# Influencing

- Include dementia-readiness in key housing, design and planning policies and strategies, including the reframed HAPPI principles
- Improve post-diagnostic support and assessments to include housing circumstances and care and support planning for people with dementia and their carers

## Information and advice

- Ensure the voices of older people, including those affected by dementia, and their carers, are heard within the decision-making processes of the Local Authority
- Adopt 'dementia friendliness' and housing and dementia guidance
