



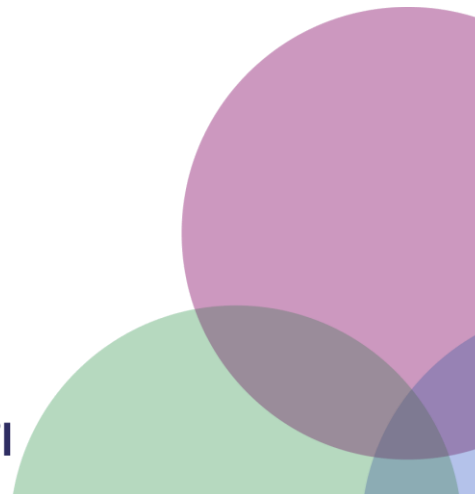

PROJECT AIMS



- We are asking disabled people aged 45 and over to tell us about what they like and dislike about where they live
- The project started in September 2022 and finishes in September 2027





WHAT WOULD THIS PROJECT INVOLVE IF YOU WANTED TO TAKE PART?

We would like to know:

- More about your home and where you live
- Train you as researcher in your area

Because you are the expert on YOU and your experiences

IMPORTANT- You can start and stop being a part of the project at any time





NEIGHBOURHOOD MAPPING

Tell us about where you live

- What outside space do you have (own garden, community park)
- Tell us how you travel





REFLECTIVE DIARY

Tell us about you

- What do you like and dislike about where you live?
- What makes your life easier in and around your home?
- What makes life more difficult?





HOW DO I TELL YOU ABOUT MY HOME




- You can choose how to do this. For example, voice recording or writing it down
- We can send you reminders to do this





PAYMENT FOR TAKING PART



- £25 voucher when we ask you for
 - A neighbourhood map
 - 5 reflective diaries
 - To attend training
 - To attend an event
 - All travel costs and other expenses will be covered
 - There will be no penalty if you withdraw – you will still be paid for your time given to the project

GIVING CONSENT

- The law says that we need to ask you before we record the interviews with you get your experiences in between interviews
- The law says that you need to tell us that it is ok for us to use the voice recordings of you and other information you provide
- If you agree to take part in the study, please sign the Consent Form given to you
- If you change your mind you can stop talking to us and do not need to tell us why



WHAT HAPPENS WITH THE INFORMATION I SHARE?



- Your real name will not be used when we report the results of the study
- What you tell us will only be used for this project
- The information will be kept for 5 years on a password protected computer at the University of Stirling
