











- LEGEND**
-  Proposed large trees
 -  Proposed small trees/large specimen shrubs
 -  Proposed ornamental hedging
 -  Proposed native hedging
 -  Proposed native shrub planting
 -  Proposed ornamental shrub/perennial planting, mostly tall species more than 1.2m (4 feet) mature height
 -  Proposed ornamental shrub/perennial planting, low species up to 1.2m (4 feet) mature height
 -  Proposed amenity grass, including existing grass areas regraded and reseeded as necessary

Notes on sensory planting:
 The planting will be designed to stimulate a number of senses, for instance:
 Trees such as *Betula Jacquemontii* and *Prunus serrula*, which have brightly coloured bark (white and red respectively), smooth to the touch. Birch leaves also rustle in the breeze, giving a pleasant sound.
 Plants which have soft leaves, pleasant to touch, eg *Artemisia*, *Stachys*, *Convolvulus*, or leaf buds (*Salix Wehrhahnii*).
 Plants with scented leaves, eg *Rosmarinus*, *Salvia* and *Lavender*.
 Plants with strongly scented flowers, eg *Dianthus* (pinks), *Philadelphus*, *Buddleia* (a fairly low growing variety).
 Variety in the size and shapes of leaves, from small and narrow (*Rosemary*, *Lavender*) to large and round (*Bergenia*).
 Plants with particularly brightly coloured flowers (*Geranium Russell Prichard*, *Lavandula Hidcote*), and variety in the colours of foliage, eg *Artemesia*: grey, *Bergenia Purpurea*: purple.
