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Step Down from Hospital

- Adults discharged from hospital with no ongoing medical need to stay in hospital but cant immediately return home
- Accessible apartment with own kitchen and bathroom to hotel standard
- Care and Support/ reablement package tailored to each persons
- 24 hour triage + response in close radius
- Ongoing support -Independent Living Service
- Aids and adaptations
- A setting like home



Step down works well for

- •People who are recovering in hospital but can't go back home.
- •Patients with physical or emotional conditions that mean they need time to adjust to live independently again with the level of care and support that they individually require.
- •Patients who need to see how they get on with a care and support package in a place just like home.
- •Patients who are recovering from a fracture or an operation.
- •Patients can be of any age, gender and ability to access this accommodation as long as there is a space and they meet the criteria above.



Features

- Fully furnished apartment ready to move in to.
- Just like home partners can stay and families and friends can visit any time.
- No charge at all to the patient. A quiet environment to aid rest and recovery.
- Fully adapted bathroom, equipped kitchen and wide-screen TV in each apartment.
- Practical and emotional support available through well-established services and trained, professional staff.
- We can help with a move to alternative accommodation if unable to return home.



Key features

- The apartments are offered free to patients for up to 12 weeks with fully funded care and support reablement packages to meet each person's needs.
- Transport: Curo colleagues do come and collect people from hospital, transport them to the apartments and help them to settle in.
- Care packages are provided out of our local Extra Care Schemes by experienced and qualified staff.
- Support from our Independent Living Service is also offered and tailor-made to the individual. All FREE to patient as part of the package.








