Who is the workshop aimed at?

The day is open to commissioners and providers. The workshop will be of particular interest to anyone interested in developing an asset based approach to organisational development. The day will be spent sharing practical learning and tools to help you maximise the effectiveness of staff, build more reciprocal relationships with people and communities and improve outcomes for people using services.

What will the workshop provide?

The workshop will introduce you to new tools to help build an understanding of the gifts, skills and talents held within your organisation and will share MacIntyre’s experience in using these tools as a springboard to engage with people, families and staff in developing people’s capacity to contribute and make a difference.

The workshop will be jointly led by Groundswell and MacIntyre and will share the learning from MacIntyre’s two year long “**People Plus**” programme to develop the gifts skills and talents of everyone connected with the organisation. We will explore the learning gained from all key stages of the programme

- Engaging and preparing for change
- Developing and implementing an asset based development programme through focusing on gifts, skills and talents
- Embedding co-production and reviewing progress

In addition, a follow up workshop will be held in the autumn for those interested in planning to develop their own asset based organisational development programmes.
