Why a Deaf-specific EXTRA CARE service?

Appropriate cultural and Sign Language environment **PREVENT** isolation and lack of social stimulation

How will this reduce isolation?

A cultural, accessible and Sign Language environment will mitigate high levels of **MENTAL ILLNESS** common among older Deaf people

Our Aim:

"To respond to the cultural, communication, sign language, housing, care, accessibility, security and lifestyle needs of the older Deaf person"



Buildings to be designed and equipped to be **fit for purpose** to enhance access, communication, culture and Sign Language Specific needs of older

KEY PRINCIPLES

Majority of staff recruited and trained to facilitate care in the 'communication mode of choice' such as Sign Language

Activity based care enhancing health and wellbeing

DEAF UTOPIA PATHWAY

Community Consultation to explore geographical need and values of the project



Stakeholder Consultation to determine scope and funding models required for the design, build and running of the facility



Identification of interested financial partners



Location, type of provision and anticipated funding model confirmed by partners



Confirmation of management arrangements, protocols for pilot project, bespoke build and conference activity



Clear pathways to commissioning and engagement of commissioners


