

What collaborative housing offers in a pandemic: Evidence from 18 communities in England and Wales

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What do we define as 'collaborative housing'?

A deliberately broad definition, encompassing cohousing, community land trusts, and housing co-operatives, as well as other models. But key, a scheme is:

- Self-managed by its residents
- Of a physical design that supports social interaction, usually including shared space and resources
- Of a size that encourages a sense of community – as a rule of thumb no more than 40 households, no fewer than 10.
