#### What is it?

Amazon Echo is a digital voice assistant, it will respond to any of your spoken commands, from setting an alarm to searching the web to answer your burning questions or even playing music.

The microphones on the device are constantly learning, too, adapting to your speech patterns, vocabulary and personal preferences. The device is constantly updating the way Alexa listens and responds, adding new abilities and will eventually provide an interface with natural-sounding responses.




#### What can it do?

To activate the device, simple say "Alexa" followed by a request. If it can't do it, it will let you know.

Try some of these examples:

- Play music or radio stations: "Alexa, play some jazz"
- Get weather reports: "Alexa, do I need an umbrella?"
- Check your schedule: "Alexa, how does my day look?"
- Play audio books and read articles: "Alexa, listen to The Bell Jar audiobook"
- Find facts: "Alexa, how old is the Queen?"
- Tell jokes: "Alexa, tell me a joke"
- Help you exercise: "Alexa, start 7-minute workout"
- Wake up to your favourite song: "Alexa, wake me at 8am to Good Vibrations by the Beach Boys"
- Control your Smart TV: "Alexa, open iPlayer"
