"We should think about homes as more than bricks and mortar. We need to see homes as places for connection, housing should support inclusion not seclusion and integration not segregation. Houses are fixed but people's lives aren't"

"Speak about translating government reform, developing system transformation and working smarter with service delivery sounds a world away from the human connection you build with people"

"What we are, are human beings, enriched by the **tapestry of our identities** from faith to our economic situation, shaped by the showing of the way when we were kids, any trauma we have been exposed to and the beliefs and values we hold" "We need to take the same approach that allows a person to bring the richness of their **multifaceted layers**, rather than their lived experience alone" "My top tip for co-production is being aware of what it takes to do coproduction well...

What lies behind the engagement is the adoption of coproduction being understood and embedded in the culture, a co-designed strategy, a budget for remuneration, acceptance that it needs to be led by the process rather then deadlines. If these aspects are considered with equal importance, then you'll soon be reaping the rewards"
