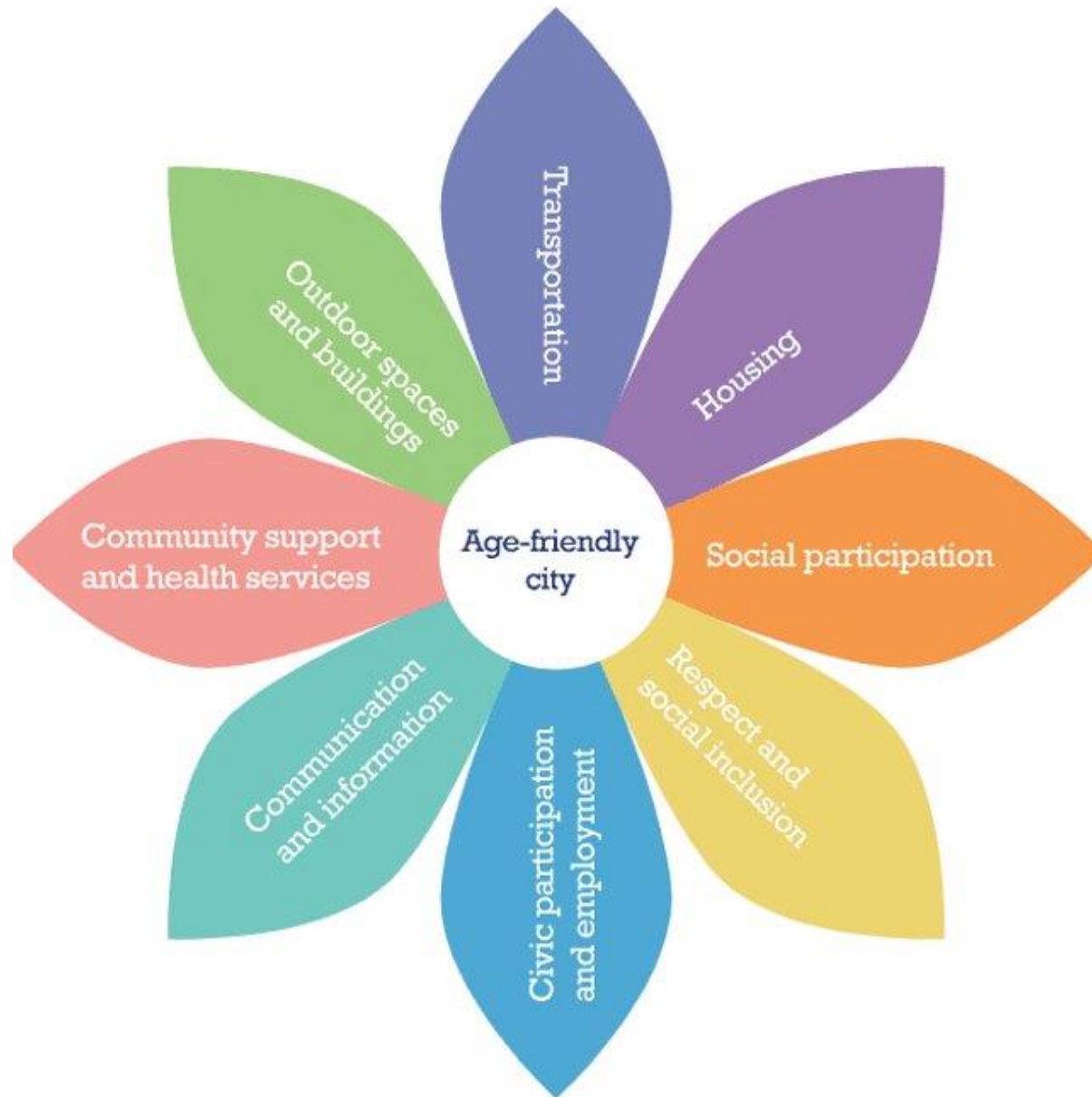
Ageing populations – challenges and opportunities for how we can support people to age in place

- To **co-design solutions** with key stakeholder groups to achieve 'actionable' interventions that support healthy ageing for older people in response to the climate crisis

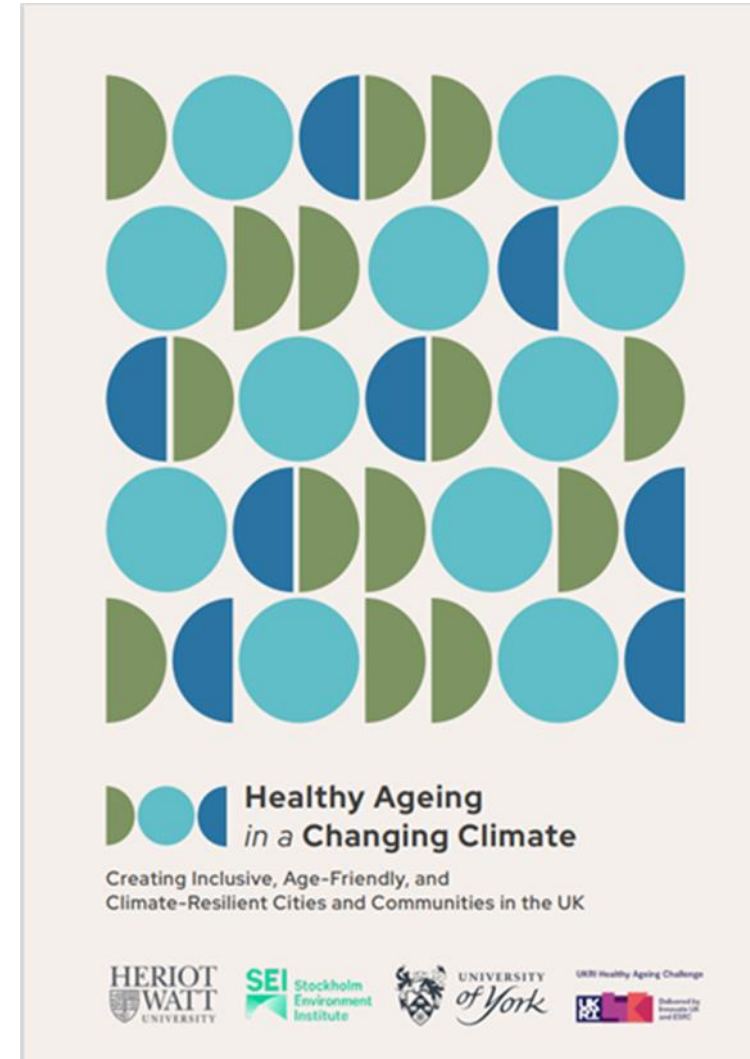
