



Developing Our Strategy – background

- Cardiff's Housing Strategy (2016-2021) gave a commitment to develop a separate Older Persons' strategy
- 2018 Research was commissioned to identify future housing and associated care requirements of older people across Cardiff and Vale.
- Housing LIN commissioned
 - □ Review of **current provision** of older persons housing;
 - □ impact of **demographic changes**
 - Review of the care and support needs of those living in older person's accommodation or on the waiting list for this.
 - □ Consideration of **residents views** through survey and focus groups.
 - Housing Association focus groups




