

Group 1	 Poor staff training Lack of proportionality Relevant questions at relevant points Out of date terminology 	 Data sets/ questions being clear for purpose & data used anonymously Coordination and information sharing Using existing data where relevant
Group 2	 Individuals – ignorance/ assumptions/ lack of training Organisational – institutional ways to working Forms – can be standard but questions asked differently Portability – cross boundaries and travellers 	 Training – make no's live – have meaning Invest in the right people e.g. processes/ data collection Coproduction – all Link strategy and operation – embed
Group 3	 Boring – "back office" Negative perception from/by public Misinterpretation of context Rules of engagement/ quality procedures 	 Better and broader communication of use/intent, etc "why are we collecting this from you?" Better sharing of existing data And need to retain the context of the collected data Establishing better communication Good data collection practice
