

PROFESSIONAL NETWORKING MEETING ONLINE

The ABAJ team hosted an initial Zoom meeting on 28th November bringing together for the first time around 20 professionals and policy makers with interests in housing, ageing, planning, design, and more, to consider current and future plans for the 'probin' community within the London Boroughs of Tower Hamlets, Newham, Hackney and Redbridge and beyond. Chaired by the Housing LIN's Jeremy Porteus, the team were able to get better information about what findings from the project will potentially be of interest/use to various stakeholders, and about how the research can be most impactful. Over the next few months the team will draw together a Professional Advisory Group (PAG) to work with them, running alongside the established BRAG, to help inform relevant policy and strategy formation, new housing provision and service developments.
