Objectives

We want to inspire you to develop into our sector's future leaders.

We are looking to attract 8 early career professionals and successful applicants can look forward to face-to-face and/or virtual sessions in 2023/24, each with presentations from at least 2 hand-picked leaders.

The objective of each session is to encourage and create space for participants to listen and learn from these experts, ask questions, share ideas and participate in facilitated discussion. During each session participants will:

- explore and discover their aspirations for leadership, and
- get practical hints and tips that may help their professional development.

The Housing LIN is looking for up to 8 early career professionals from the housing and care sector to be part of the 3rd cohort of our **Future Leaders Programme**. We aim to hold our first session in July this year.

To be considered for the **Future Leaders Programme**, please send your CV along with a concise statement (250-300 words) outlining your reasons for taking part and what you would bring to the network, as well as a letter of support from your employer on headed notepaper confirming that they will release you to participate in the programme.

The deadline for submissions is c.o.p Friday, 12 May 2023. We hope to notify successful applicants in early June and hold our first session in late July.
