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### INDEPENDENT LIVING SERVICE BANDING

<b>Emergency Alarm only £3.25 per week</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Access to a 24 hour emergency alarm centre</li><li>• Access to social and recreational activities at the scheme</li><li>• Regular newsletters and information</li><li>• Service upgrade to a higher level of support following a reassessment of your support needs</li></ul>
<b>Low Band £6.50 per week (inclusive of lifeline costs)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Optional alarm service giving help in an emergency via this alarm</li><li>• Basic information and advise along with signposting to appropriate services</li><li>• Access to social and recreational activities at the scheme</li><li>• Low level support plan to help staff monitor your individual support needs</li><li>• Access to emergency support if required</li><li>• Service upgrade to a higher level of support on request of a needs assessment</li><li>• Regular newsletters and information</li><li>• Minimum 6 monthly wellbeing visits</li></ul>

<p><b>Medium Band</b>  <b>£17.25</b>  <b>(inclusive of lifeline costs)</b></p>	<p>As above plus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A detailed assessment of your support needs reviewed on an annual basis and/or triggered by a significant change in your needs.</li> <li>• Regular wellbeing checks (no more than once per week)</li> <li>• This level of service is intended for those people who have been assessed as at risk of losing elements of independence</li> <li>• This level of support aims to maintain and increase your independence. Some parts of the service are aimed at preventing a crisis.</li> </ul>
<p><b>High Band</b>  <b>£33.25</b>  <b>(inclusive of lifeline charges)</b></p>	<p>As above plus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to 5 wellbeing checks per week to meet your support needs</li> <li>• Assess and agree your support needs taking into account input from other agencies and reviewed 6 monthly and/or triggered by a significant change in your needs.</li> <li>• Liaise with appropriate agencies to arrange joint support planning meetings</li> <li>• The aim of this level of support is to enable you to gain and/or retain your independence so you can remain at home or could move to a lower band if appropriate.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Transitional Band</b>  <b>FREE – max 6 wks</b>  <b>(Crisis band)</b></p>	<p>Available from any band where additional, more intensive support is required, above that which is currently being provided and a reassessment of support needs is required. For example, bereavement, period of sickness or a stay in hospital.</p>
