The Trust is has developed a proposal with LB Southwark to undertake a pilot Intermediate Care Project at Lomond Hse. This site comprises a Sheltered Housing Scheme, Residential Unit and Lunch Club. The project will focus on a 'social model' of Intermediate Care offering both residential and day care places as a step down facility.
