

Research with a focus on translation to enable business impact

- DesHCA Designing Homes for healthy Cognitive Ageing: co-production for impact and scale
- ENLIVEN Extending active life for older people with cognitive impairment and their families through innovation in the visitor economy of the natural environment
- SPACE addressing cognitive health inequality by investigating the impacts, and possible mechanistic pathways, of urban environments on healthy ageing and cognitive health, and on diverse individuals and communities.
