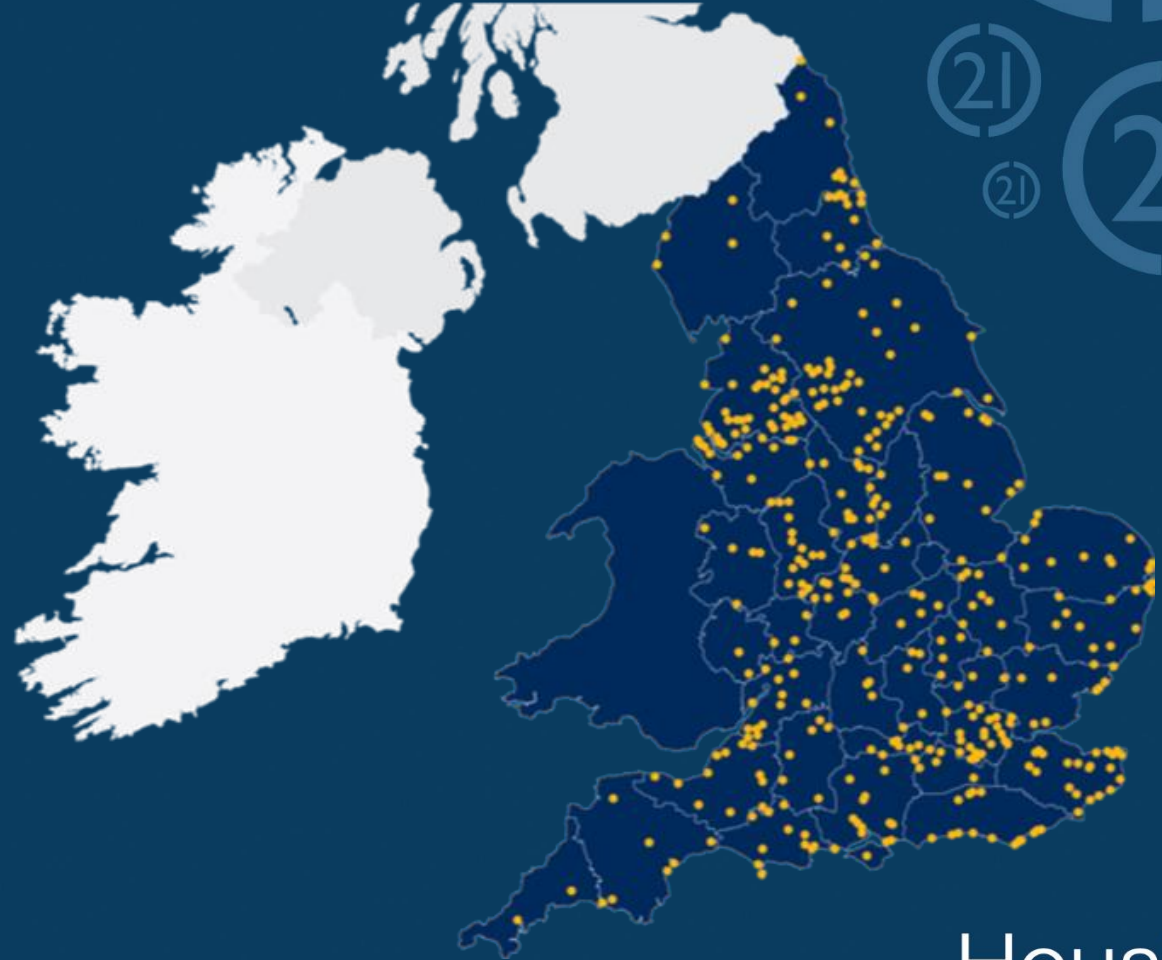

## Housing for People with Dementia

**1 in 3** of today's new borns will live to see their 100th birthday.<sup>1</sup>



The Dementia and Housing Working Group (DHWG), aims to promote and encourage the housing sector to improve the health, wellbeing and quality of life for people living with dementia.

The DHWG has support from a range of organisations and institutions with an interest in dementia and housing. These include several housing associations, universities, architects and Government departments.

### What have we been up to?

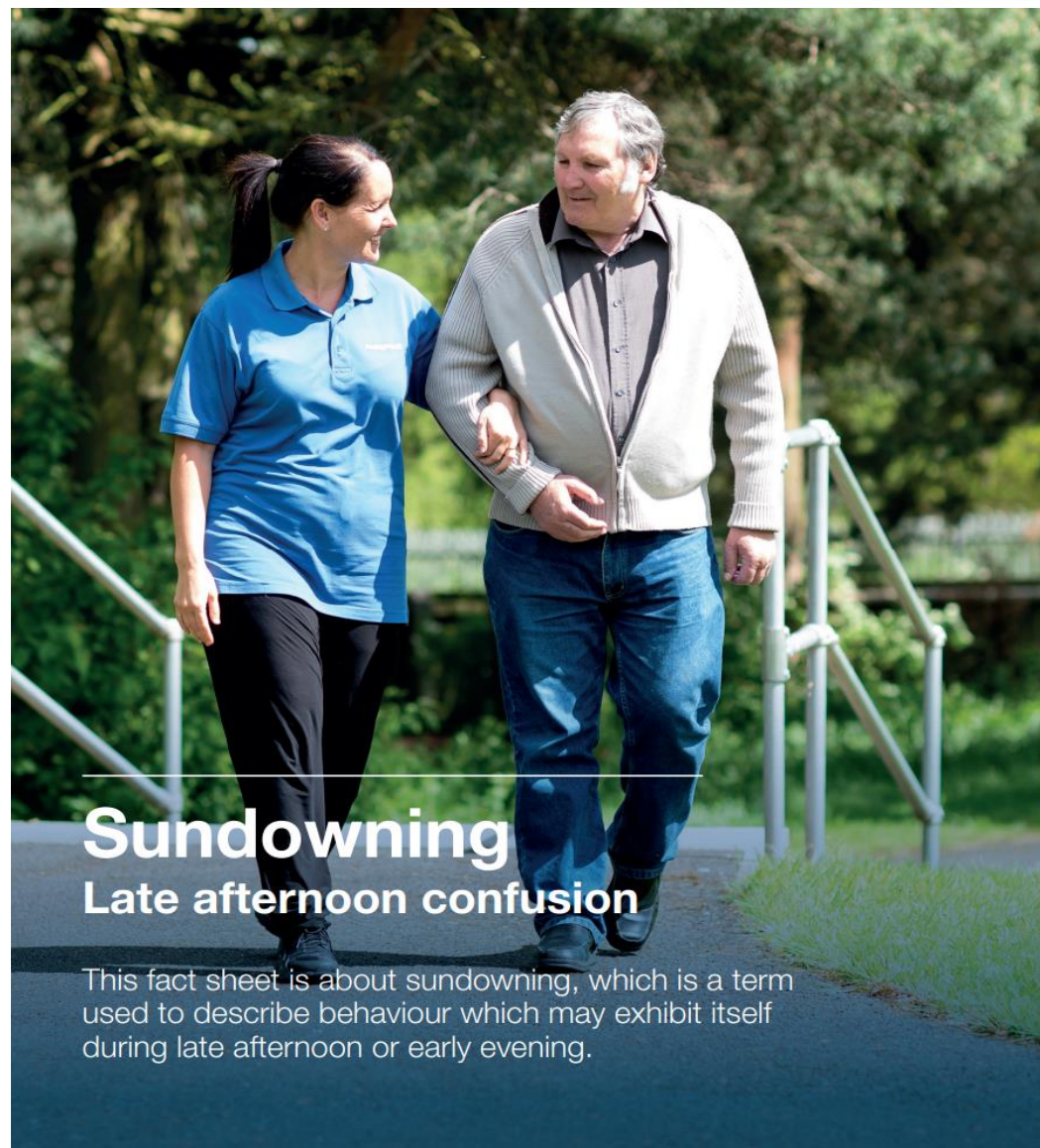
At the UK Dementia Congress in 2020, DHWG presented an Integrated Care Model, demonstrating how important it is to recognise how design and digital technology can support those with dementia.

We have also created a 'Digital and Technology' sub-group, within DHWG, which is led by Johnnie Johnson Housing, Walker Simpson Architects and Hornsey Consulting. The sub-group is developing a strategy for easy access to dementia-friendly design, technology and information to support the delivery of Recommendation 34 of The All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on Housing and Care for Older People Report link. 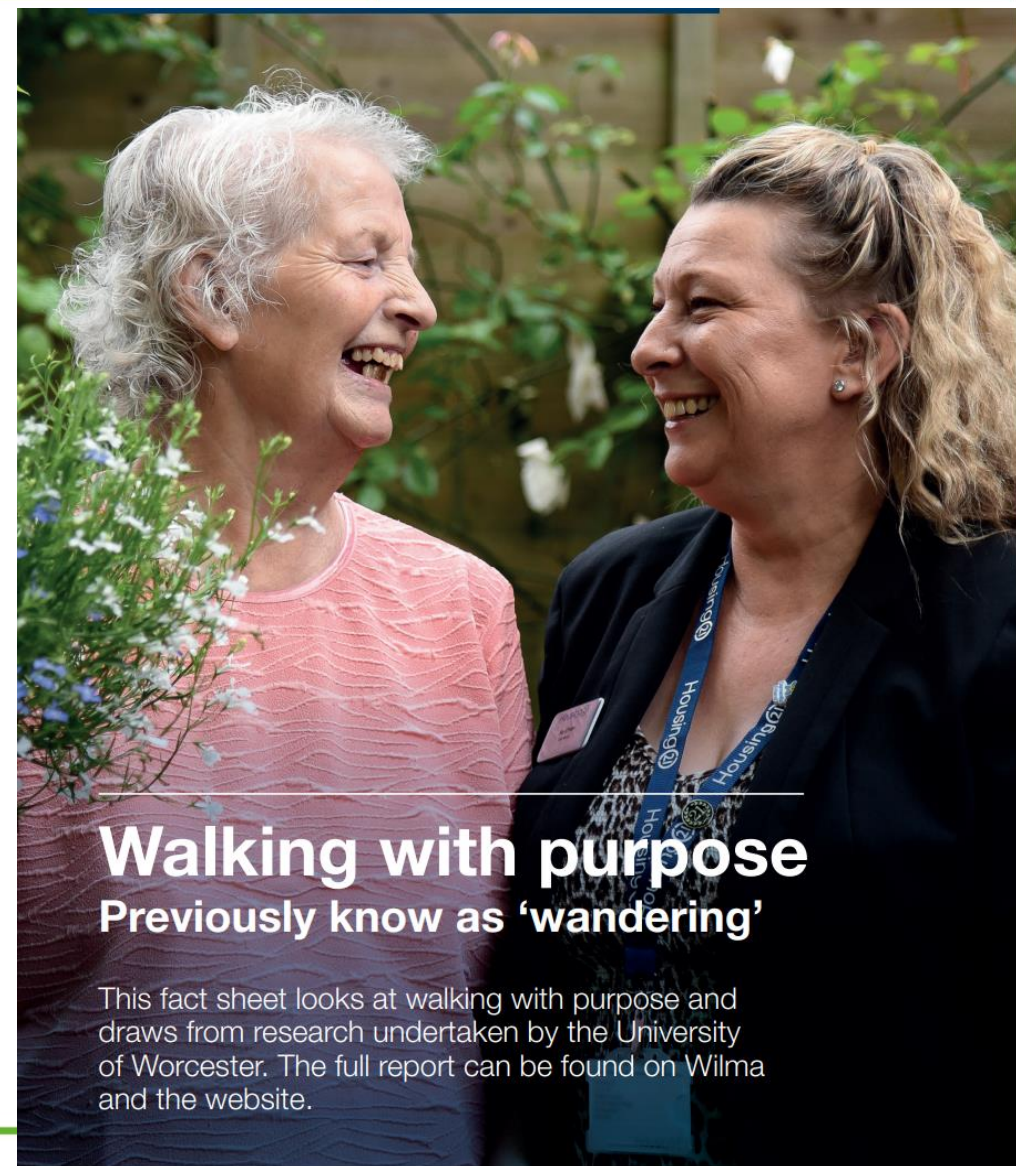


# Housing 21 activity – Information / guidance / awareness

This fact sheet is about sundowning, which is a term used to describe behaviour which may exhibit itself during late afternoon or early evening.

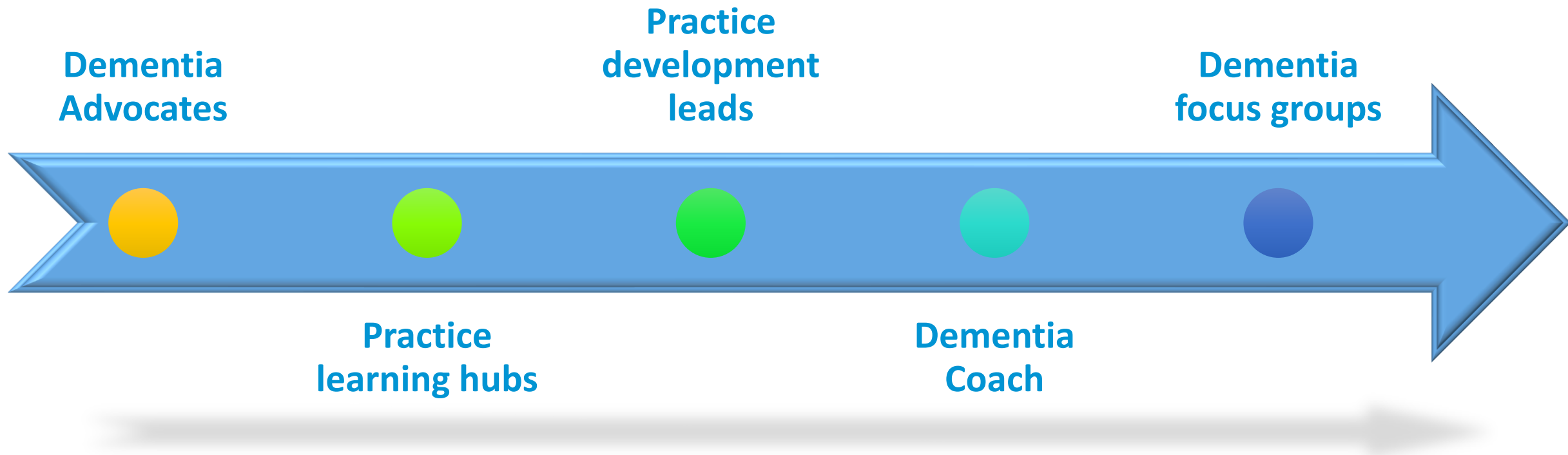


## **Walking with purpose** Previously known as 'wandering'
